Mysore has surpassed them efficaciously. At this juncture, I am immensely delighted and proud to present before you, the highlights of the year gone by, that are a testimony to our success stories despite the pandemic.

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## **SPOTLIGHT**

**Ranking in Education World** - The September edition of Education World magazine featured the best schools across India, under various categories. It is a proud feather in the cap of the team, as NPSI Mysore bagged the Numero Uno spot in the Education World Co-Ed day school ranking in Mysore and to be placed at No. 44 amongst the day schools in Karnataka.

It gives us immense pleasure and pride to announce that the **Term 1 Board Results of the Academic Year 2022**, with respect to the current batch, have been fantastic. Though the pattern of the exam was changed, an exclusive preparation programme was put in place to help students to face the assessments with confidence. This resulted



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in our students securing top notch marks and many centums in both Class 12 and Class 10. **A total of 62 centums were secured by Grade 10 students and 21 centums by Grade 12 students.** The statistics are given below for your perusal. Congratulations to teachers, students and parents for these superb results. As we continue to surge ahead with added zeal and effort, to help our students excel in the forthcoming Term 2 Board Exams, we hope that these results will spur our students to work harder.

## **RESULTS OF ACADEMIC YEAR 2020-21**

The academic year 2020-21 commenced with good tidings. The AISSE scores of class 10 were outstanding, with 100% results and all 53 students securing a class average of 86.3%. A total of 40 students scored above 80% and centums in English, Math and Social Science was an added feather to the cap. Sritama Ghosh emerged as the topper of the batch, scoring an aggregate of 98.6%.

Team NPSI Mysore witnessed 100% results in the AISSCE Class 12 results too, with the class average being 84.86%, 84.83% and 89.65% in the Science, Commerce and Humanities streams respectively. Jeevika emerged as the topper in the Science Stream scoring an aggregate of 96.6%, The topper in the Commerce stream was Adithya Ramaprasad securing 97.6% and in the Humanities Stream, it was Ananya Varma with 96.6%. The highest scores in most subjects was 99 and the centum scored by Adithya in Economics, was the icing on the cake.

## **EVENTUALLY EVENTFUL...**

The academic year saw many uncertainties with respect to reopening of on-campus school. Nevertheless, a plethora of events were conducted with great enthusiasm and fervour, in both online and offline modes. Given below is a sneak peek into a few of them.

1. **The World Environment Day** was observed on 5 June 2021, on the virtual platform at NPSI Mysore. This initiative, brought together, the enthusiastic young learners of the Primary Years who enjoyed humming along a meaningful tune to preserve Earth. The budding environmentalists potted saplings, sketched and painted meaningful messages, spreading awareness and pledging to save this planet for generations to come!
2. At the beginning of 2021-22 we were all caught, right in the middle of the storm called the Covid. An awareness drive regarding the pandemic was conducted in June through the **Covid Awareness Week**. Age appropriate videos, talks, story narration and counselling programmes were organised for all students from pre-primary to Class 12 that enlightened students about numerous strategies, to overcome the challenges during these unprecedented times, with grit and courage.
3. **Founder's Day** was celebrated at NPSI Mysore on 14 June 2021, to express gratitude and reverence to Dr K P Gopalkrishna, Dr Mrs. Shamthamma Gopalkrishna, Dr Bindu Hari and other founding members, for giving us this temple of knowledge that we can be so proud of. The maiden edition of the digital yearbook was launched. Students of class X enthralled the audience with melodious music, vocals and dynamic dance moves. The students also shared their experiences at the institution and expressed their earnest gratitude to the founders and the educators.
4. The first online **Student Council Election** process was held at NPSI Mysore with preparation of the e-ballot, e-filing of nominations, virtual campaigning, rigorous online screening rounds and finally, the much-awaited



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awaited result declaration. The newly appointed Student Council Members, House Leaders and Association Heads, were inducted into the student body officially during the **Investiture Ceremony**, held virtually. It was a scintillating programme interspersed with melody and dance. The highlight of the event was, proud parents conferring the sash for their wards. The new leaders, the chosen brand ambassadors, pledged to uphold the values of the institution and keep the school flag flying high.

5. The maiden commerce fest- '**COGITO MERX- Creating Magic with Merchandise**' was held on 7 August, 2021. A total of 19 teams from various reputed schools took part in the event. The event commenced with a galactic inauguration programme. The entire programme, was planned, organised and executed by the senior secondary students. Conducted virtually, the event was interspersed with music, dance and trivia, to keep the attendees involved. There were four rigorous rounds in all, aimed at testing the business acumen, wits and reasoning skills of contestants. The participants put up outstanding presentations in the given time frame, that kept everyone at the edge of their seats and making the choice of winners, challenging for the jury. The eventful day concluded with a scintillating valedictory ceremony. The fest was definitely a class apart and is sure to be reminisced as one of the best events, hosted by NPSI Mysore.
6. **Scilore** has always given a boost to the scientific spirit in young learners of NPSI Mysore. This year too, the students left no stone unturned in showcasing their expertise in the field of Mathematics, Computer Science, Science and Social Science. October 23 witnessed the live streaming of first e-Scilore. All students from Pre-primary to class 9 and class 11 took part in the event, covering a wide array of topics, ranging from life cycle of a butterfly to the impact of COVID-19 on Indian economy. Students demonstrated many experiments through creative working models, enthralling role plays and mesmerizing movies. The event concluded with a grand valedictory ceremony where the prize winners were felicitated and the exclusive e-magazine of the senior years, SYnergy, was launched.
7. **The Young Entrepreneurship Programme** 2021-22 was unique as the entire event was strategized, designed and executed virtually. The students, astounded NPSI fraternity with their 'out of box' ideas and proved that the spirit of entrepreneurship prevails in all of us. The profits, generated from the sales proceeds were donated to Divya Jyothi Charitable Trust (For the Disabled), Dattagalli, Mysore. This year's YEP not only saw the best creative minds at work, but also witnessed the humane approach adopted by our students.
8. The first virtual sports meet, **Digi Sportacus** was conducted for students of pre-primary to Class 12. It was heart-warming to see enthusiastic participation and energetic show of sporting talents, across all sectors. A host of competitions, with fitness as the core theme, was held for the participants, who displayed the highest levels of commitment and sportsmanship, to make the event, a grand success.
9. The **Seventh Graduation Ceremony** was celebrated on 5 March 2022. This was the first mega event held on campus. The motivational speeches by the honorable members of the Board, special mentor moments video by the teachers, the exclusive student and parent expressions, the melodious music and graceful dance- all added to the magic of the evening, making it even more galactic. The programme was infused with gratitude, emotions and a trip down the memory lane, which will be treasured in our hearts forever.
10. The tiny tots of the senior KG and Montessori graduated from pre-school on 18 March 2022. The grand **Pre-Primary Graduation Day** was held on campus, in the presence of esteemed parents of the graduating batch. Music, dance and heartfelt speeches of the young graduating orators were the highlight of the event.





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11. Our students participated in a host of interschool events and inter house competitions through the year and bagged several accolades. The winners of pre-primary were felicitated on **Accoladay** held on 26 March and students from classes 1-12 were presented with their certificates and medals on Accoladay held on 30 March 2022. E Caleb Bastian from class 12 was declared as the best outgoing student of the year for overall excellence in academics and co-scholastics and for upholding the values of integrity, commitment and humility throughout the school years.
12. **Class assemblies, field Trips and guest lectures** were held virtually throughout the two terms. These experiences beyond the classroom walls were insightful and knowledge enhancing. The virtual field trips were nothing short of a global expedition. The on-campus field trip to BEML for the senior year students provided the much needed break from the monotony of online field trips. Experts from diverse domains shared their expertise on various areas during guest lectures. The primary year students participated in class assemblies, that were organised on a variety of themes, showcasing their exquisite talents.
13. Communication is one of the key principles that leads to success and progress. Keeping this in mind, a host of **Orientation and Connect Programmes**, both, online as well as, on campus, were conducted for parents and students of all classes to apprise them of the curriculum and teaching-learning initiatives implemented at school. Parent and student queries regarding hybrid classes, written assessments and stream choices were aptly addressed. I also met many parent partners one-on-one, to gain a deeper insight into their experiences, expectations and concerns, that helped me to establish a stronger network with the parent fraternity in Mysore.
14. **Webinars and Career Counselling** programmes were organised by the school, in collaboration with various top-notch universities, to help the students make the right career choices. Leading universities and career institutes such as Flame, Ashoka, KREA and Gen Next, enlightened the students about the curriculum choices and selection criteria.
15. Building a strong foundation in creative thinking and writing amongst young minds, can go a long way in strengthening language and vocabulary. **Spin- a -Tale and novel writing** are the inspirational initiatives launched by Dr. Bindu Hari, that inculcate creativity and love for writing in young adolescents. These programmes, conducted for students of Class 5, saw myriad expressions in diverse genres. The budding writers received a lot of appreciation from parents and teachers.
16. **Teacher empowerment programmes** endeavoured to create a resource pool of enriched and knowledge equipped facilitators. Programmes like ILead and Learn, Teach, Engage conducted by the NPS Management and TTA, Bangalore, the in-house technical training etc were richly infused with information that was needed to cater to the demands of quality education consistently, despite the challenges of the pandemic. **Capacity building programmes** for seamless content delivery and student engagement initiatives were actively conducted through the year.
17. The **staff well-being initiatives** included entertainment programmes and games, that brought a smile on every faculty members' face. Watching '83, a movie that celebrated India's first victory in World Cup Cricket, was also a part of team building endeavours, **Vaccination drives**, in collaboration with the city health department, were organised for teachers and senior year students, reinforcing the fact that the health and well-being of our staff and students' has always been a priority.



18. **Olympiads** in English, Math, G K and General Science were held online and a large number of students took part in this test, that is held every year across the country.

# *From The Principal's Desk*

## **TO HUMBLE AND SUCCESSFUL BEGINNINGS...**

1. **Board Exams** – For the first time in 8 years, the school was allocated as the center to conduct the Term 1 CBSE Board Exams. All procedural formalities were aptly complied with and the exams were successfully conducted for Grades 10 & 12.
2. **Booklovers' Hub** - Team NPSI Mysore believes that the influence of readers has far reaching impact and it is here, that we had our young bibliophiles to pitch in! The Booklovers' Hub, was created to inculcate the reading habit in young learners of classes 5 to 8. Through the numerous sessions that were conducted, the group of panellists successfully created the right effect, like the ripples in a pond, prompting the audience to explore the world of books and cultivate the habit of reading.
3. **SYnergy** - It has been my strong belief that creativity and imagination should be given the wings of expression. It is said that the pen, is more powerful than a sword, because language and words have the capacity to create, transform or destroy. Our students in the senior years have several accomplishments to their credit! The out-of-the box ideas, thoughts and expressions, that our teenage buddies have, need to be recognised and encouraged by the world. So we designed an outlet, a platform, exclusively to showcase the expressions of the SY sector. It is with this idea in mind, that we decided to create a melange of stories, talents, feats, art and expressions! And so...the maiden edition of a virtual SY sector magazine,. SYnergy – an amalgam of SY energy - was born.
4. **Monthly Transaction Reports**, a journal for parents and students of classes 1-8, was created to keep parents abreast about the happenings at school. With sections that included star of the month award, teachers' expressions and students' voice, the journal received a lot of acclaim.
5. Online classes and virtual sessions had left the students glued to their screens. **Campus Euphoria** was the "Back to School" campaign, where students from the primary years were invited to school for a day to indulge in music, dance and PE. **School is Cool** - a similar initiative was conducted for students in the early learning group. This was a welcome change for the young minds, that were confined to their homes for almost 2 years at a stretch. Children thoroughly enjoyed the activities and demanded for more such breaks.
6. **Parent Partnership Programme**- an initiative aimed at helping the parent partners of the Early Learning Group, to transition from Zoom to Teams and understand the nitty gritty of the MS Teams platform, was organised on Saturdays. This hand-holding led to successful adaptation of the pedagogical tools on MS Teams.
7. Continuous **Academic Support** was provided to students across sectors through **Exclusive Learning Programmes and Bridging Sessions**. **Reading programmes**, included as part of the curriculum, was another step towards building English communication skills, that are vital for all-round performance. Students were grouped and individual attention was provided to students who needed special care for academic success. The learning gaps, if any, were bridged, thus strengthening concept foundation and basic skills.
8. **Special support** was provided to **students** who continued learning with us, **from abroad**, during the pandemic. Classes and assessments were conducted for them in their convenient time zones and academic material was constantly uploaded on the Teams platform, for their reference and for uninterrupted progressive learning.



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9. Students in the Primary Years were faced with the challenge of **mastering languages like Kannada, Hindi and English**. This was their first exposure to multiple languages and the foundation had to be strengthened for ease of linguistic comprehension in future. Continued all-inclusive support was provided to students, that helped to strengthen the vernacular basics.
10. The academic year began with teaching-learning, largely on the virtual mode. A revamped time-table that was developed, ensured an equal **balance between academics and co-scholastic domains**. Special classes in Art & Craft, Music, Dance and PE, saw 100 % attendance in all sectors and students enjoyed the creatively curated co-scholastic classes online.
11. In this era of information empowerment, the year saw us making tremendous **digital progress** in multiple dimensions. All classrooms were refurbished with **interactive panels and upgraded LAN** to ensure smoothness and efficiency in the pedagogical processes. The **Parent App** was set afloat for quick, transparent and continuous communication with our parent partners. The **Acadamis portal** started being actively used for updates on students' progress and for sending other important notifications to parents.
12. **Infrastructural excellence** was sustained all-round the year with rigorous maintenance work undertaken in classrooms, labs, library, auditorium, the pool area and the playground turf. This ensured that students returned to school, to enjoy the best quality facilities, that NPS has always provided them with.
